General remarks and official action taken:


On this day came on for consideration by the Commissioner of Insurance the matter of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation, Shelby Casualty Insurance Company, The Shelby Insurance Company, and Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company domiciled the State of Texas, and doing the business of insurance in the State of Texas. On August 1, 2006 the 126th Judicial District Court of Travis County, Texas entered an Order Appointing Liquidator in Cause No. D-1-GN-06-002366, finding Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation, Shelby Casualty Insurance Company, The Shelby Insurance Company, and Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company to be insolvent.

Based upon the finding of insolvency by the 126th Judicial District Court, and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.28-C, the Commissioner of Insurance finds that Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation, Shelby Casualty Insurance Company, The Shelby Insurance Company, and Texas Select Lloyds Insurance Company should be, and are hereby, designated as impaired insurers as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.28-C §5(9), effective August 1, 2006.
