General remarks and official action taken:

On this day came on for consideration by the Commissioner of Insurance the matter of Reinsurance Company of America, Inc. ("RCA, Inc."), organized in Illinois and doing insurance business in the State of Texas. On April 27, 2011, the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois entered an *Order of Liquidation with a Finding of Insolvency* in Case No. 10 CH 6207, finding RCA, Inc. to be insolvent.

Based upon the finding of insolvency by the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE Ch. 462, the Commissioner of Insurance finds that RCA, Inc. should be, and is hereby, designated as an impaired insurer as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE § 462.004(5), effective April 27, 2011.
