Designation as an Impaired Insurer under Texas Insurance Code Chapter 462

General remarks and official action taken:

The commissioner of insurance considers the matter of Lincoln General Insurance Company, a property and casualty insurer domiciled in Pennsylvania, and engaged in the business of insurance in Texas. On November 5, 2015, the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania issued an Order of Liquidation, and declared Lincoln General Insurance Company to be insolvent.

Based on these facts, the commissioner designates Lincoln General Insurance Company as an impaired insurer as defined in Tex. Ins. Code Ann. § 462.004(5), authorizing the Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association to handle covered claims of Lincoln General Insurance Company pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code Ann. Chapter 462. This designation is effective as of November 5, 2015.
